NEW HOUSING OPTION FOR STUDENTS

WCCC offers students the opportunity to live in apartments with fewer residents than the design capacity of 5 students if housing requests do not exceed housing demands. Due to the fixed costs of operating apartments, the college surcharges those students who choose to live in apartments at less than capacity. Students electing to live in an apartment housing 3 people (or less) are guaranteed a private bedroom. Each apartment contains 2 double and 1 single bedroom. Charges are based on a fixed cost of \$4,688.00 per semester.

Dormitory waivers are limited to the minimum cost per student. Charges are subject to revision by the Maine Community College System Board of Trustees.
