Since you cannot charge them, you must be prepared to pay for them that day. You must have your tools by the second week of classes. 1. Electrician's Knife - Klein #1550-11
2. Screwdrivers - plastic handles with rubber grips, either square or round shank

 - b. One 5/16" blade X 6" shank – Klein # 602- 6
 - c. One 3/8" blade X 8" shank b- Klein # 600-8
 - d. One ideal wire nut screwdriver - # 30-333
 - e. Phillips 4" shank – Klein # 603-4

8. One pair of long nose cutting pliers, 8" with plastic handles – Klein #D203-8
9. Electrician's fiberglass hammer – Klein #807-18
10. Electrician's tool pouch and belt – Belt, Klein #5207 (med.,lg.,&x-lg.) Pouch - #5178
11. Torpedo Level – Klein #930-0
